

## UPDATE ON DEBRIS REMOVAL 09/22/2008

Fort Bend County Road & Bridge Supervisor Mark Grant has informed me that it will be at least 2 to 3 weeks before the County will make a second pick up of debris.

Please be aware that you will need to have the tree limbs & other debris on the city right of way. You may also take tree limbs to our city drop off at the end of Sabine Street. The County would like to pick up as much of the tree debris at one location if possible.

I will keep you updated as we move forward with the storm clean up. I ask for your patience as we move forward with the clean up. There are a lot of areas in Fort Bend County that were impacted much more severely.

On a separate issue you may have noticed an increase in mosquitoes in the area. The County has advised us that these are saltwater mosquitoes that were blown in from the coast. All testing so far indicate no **West Nile Virus**. The City will try to get our area sprayed as soon as possible. If you have any questions please feel free to call me anytime at 832-868-6647.
